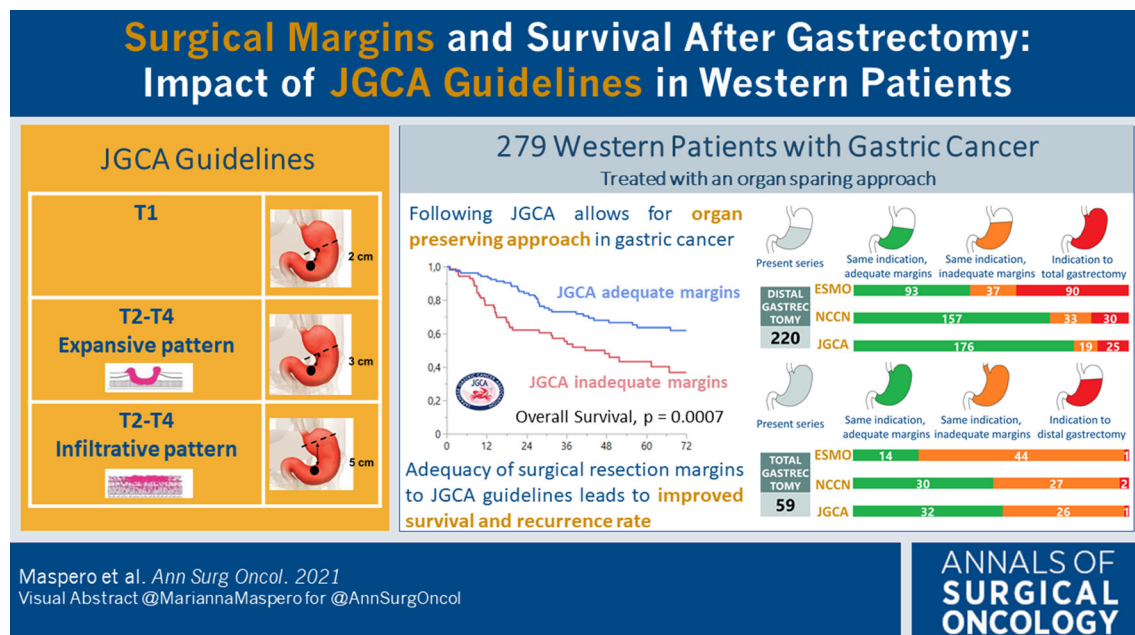
ASO Visual Abstract: Impact of Surgical Margins on Overall Survival After Gastrectomy for Gastric Cancer: A Validation of Japanese Gastric Cancer Association Guidelines on a Western Series

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In 279 consecutive Western patients undergoing gastrectomy for adenocarcinoma, margin adequacy was validated according to the Japanese Gastric Cancer Association (JGCA) guidelines (<https://doi.org/10.1245/s10434-021-11010-0>).

Compared with other guidelines, JGCA allowed more organ-sparing gastrectomies while achieving improved overall, recurrence-free, and local recurrence-free survival.



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
