




# % fulltext open access in AIR



### Implementing the FP7 Post-Grant Open Access Pilot at the University of Milan

The University of Milan is a research-intensive multidisciplinary university. It's currently the only member of LERU in Italy. The staff includes over 2000 researchers and professors and more than 1970 PhD-students and post-docs. Our researchers produce circa 8000 publications on a yearly basis – including journal articles, book chapters and monographs.

Open Access at the University of Milan is implemented via a close collaboration between the Research Office and the OA Office. Together we developed an internal procedure to streamline and enact a strong and efficient communication strategy addressed to our researchers on OA initiatives such as the FP7 Post-Grant OA Pilot and other EC initiatives.

# Le iniziative OA di ACS



## ACS Author Rewards

### Encouraging ACS authors to choose open access with a \$60-million stimulus program

Recognizing that research communities may require time to fund and transition to new open access publishing models, ACS will sponsor a direct-to-author open access stimulus program entitled *ACS Author Rewards*. During 2014, ACS will reward each Corresponding Author of every article published that year with publishing credits for a total value of \$1,500 per publication. These credits can be used to fund any ACS open access publishing option of the author's choosing within the next three years. Given the nearly 40,000 articles published across the Society's portfolio of journals annually, this stimulus program presents the research community with a potential savings on the order of \$60 million.



## ACS AuthorChoice

### Expanded to include new options to help authors meet open access requirements

Since 2006, ACS has offered the *ACS AuthorChoice* option for authors to license immediate open availability of their published articles. Effective in 2014, *ACS AuthorChoice* is being expanded to offer authors a much wider range of options, such as Creative Commons licenses and provisions for embargoed open access, coupled with Certified Article Deposit programs. One-time fees will be as low as \$750 for ACS members at subscribing institutions. Authors opting for *ACS AuthorChoice* can rely upon ACS to help manage the process of compliance with funder open access requirements.
